NEWS BRIEF – 037 - Terracotta Army at Gateway

Discover the secrets of ancient China with the Terracotta Army and the First Emperor of China exhibition at Gateway Theatre of Shopping.

The mystique and secrets of Ancient China are now on display in Durban with *The Terracotta Army and the First Emperor of China: The Exhibition* at the Gateway Theatre of Shopping.
