Directions to Mariannahill Monastery:

From Durban: stay on N3 past Pavilion & Paradise Valley/Pinetown and take exit no. 23 to M1/Richmond Road/Mariannahill. At top of exit ramp turn left into M1 for Mariannahill.

From PMB: On N3 pass Mariannahill Toll Plaza and take exit no. 23 to M1/Richmond Road/Mariannahill. At top of exit ramp turn right into M1 for Mariannahill.

From Pinetown: Take M1 (Richmond Road) under Fields Hill/M13. Follow M1 over N3.

ALL: Pass NPA testing ground on right and at first robot turn right into Abbot Francis Road. Follow road for about 0.8 km and at intersection keep right to Monastery entrance. Go through arch and keep straight for about 200 metres. Park on left or right near double glass doors ahead of you.
